
- Proactive Calls for service are Directed Patrols, Public Relations and Fire/Rescue calls.






EXAMPLE PROJECTION: RETAIL FRAUDS OSHTEMO TOWNSHIP 2015-2018.







Kalamazoo County Township Calls for Service 2015-2017 Graphed







CAD Update/New Monthly Reports

KCSO and other agencies have now received the training needed to extract data from the new CAD system. A new monthly report is being created for all townships. This new report will feature a new structure and event types, resulting in a different appearance than previous township reports. It will still include basic data from the original reports such as Calls for Service and Traffic data. This report is expected in early February of 2019. It is the goal of the Sheriff's Office that we will be able to post this report on our KCSO website for any township official or citizen to access.

The collection and analysis of stats requires extra time and specialized qualifications including a detailed understanding of the data structure and relationships. Any stat or data not provided on the general township report shall need to be specifically requested from the Undersheriff or Sheriff on an as needed basis with the specific reason for the request.
