Oshtemo Township Trends and Analysis

April saw Calls for Service in Oshtemo Township reported at **1784.** The Adjusted Calls for Service number was **1288.** This number is achieved when the calls for service complaints are subtracted by the pro-active calls for service of directed patrols, public relations and Fire and Rescue calls during this time period.

Assaults were reported at 34 for April. There was 1 Robbery reported. There were 0 Child Abuse case reported. The number of Sex Offense cases reported was reported at 0.

Retail Frauds were reported at **31** for the month of April. Larcenies were reported at **40**. Home Invasions were reported at **7**.

Non-Criminal Calls were reported at 614 for the month of April.

Miscellaneous Criminal Calls and Frauds were reported at **64** for the month of April.

Vehicle Crashes were reported at 98 for the month of April.

Traffic Summary: Total Traffic stops were 409 for the month of April.

Citations issued: Citations issued for the month of April was 196.

Detective Bureau Trends

Detectives report in April there were several arrests of suspects who were involved in the Larcenies from Automobiles in Oshtemo Township where windows were broken out of vehicles to obtain personal property. These suspects are currently in the court process of their cases.

Citizens are still reminded to be vigilant of their property and lock all vehicles left outside secured building or garages. <u>Residents are reminded to never leave purses</u>, <u>wallets</u>, <u>cell phones</u>, <u>brief cases or any other property of value in their vehicles</u>. <u>These items should be either placed in the trunk or taken inside their residence</u>.

Officers have also saw an increase in recent weeks of fake businesses calling residents attempting to get payment for fixing either computers through the internet or other payments for fake purchases. These fraud attempts to get citizens to pay for fake services through purchasing ITune cards or other gift cards instead of actual money or a credit card. If this type of fraud is suspected please contact law enforcement immediately to report the incident.

Community Policing Officer

Deputy Dave Rowe is gathering data from area hotels in Oshtemo Township in order to prepare detailed calls for service reports. These reports can be used by the Township to evaluate the level of resources which are currently being devoted to these businesses. The reports will also show if there is a need for adding specific resources to reduce service requests or a need on the business side to increase compliance requests from the Township.

Statistics are retrieved from KCSO Statistics compiled by the Operations Division at KCSO

The complaints break down into 7 categories of Calls for Service. All calls are taken from the complaints final disposition.

*Each category has several main nature categories and the remainder of the complaints which don't fall into one of these categories are placed into all others.

- b. Assaults (Assault and Batteries, Domestic Assaults, Felonious Assaults, Fights)
- c. Rape (All Criminal Sexual Conduct cases and Indecent Exposure cases)
- d. Robbery
- e. Child Abuse (Includes Child Protective Service referrals)
- f. All other violent crimes including Violation of Controlled Substance Act and Resisting and Obstructing an Officer.

2. Property Crimes

- a. Breaking & Entering (Non Dwelling)
- b. Home Invasions (Residential Dwellings)
- c. Retail Frauds
- d. Larcenies (Includes Larceny from Vehicle)
- e. Unlawful Driving Away of a Automobile

d. All Other Property Crimes related including Malicious Destruction of Property calls

3. Non Criminal Complaints

- a. Alarms (Includes False Alarms and Fire Alarms)
- b. Noise Complaints
- c. Suspicious Occurrence
- d. All other crimes which don't fit into other categories

4. Miscellaneous Criminal Complaints

- a. Frauds, Embezzlement
- b. Other

5. Vehicle Crashes

- a. Fatal
- b. Personal Injury Crashes
- c. Property Damage Crashes



- 7. Fire and Rescue (The only two categories which go into this are Fire and Rescue CFS)




