Oshtemo Township Community Survey Results

William SaintAmour of Cobalt Community Research presented the 2017 survey results to the joint boards. Cobalt Community Research is a 501c3 not-for-profit research coalition. Their mission is to provide research and education to meet the needs of schools, local governments, and nonprofit organizations. The survey was administered to a random sample of 1,500 residents drawn from voter records. Tow mailing were conducted in May and June of 2017. The Township received a statistically valid response from 367 residents, providing a conventional margin of error of +/- 5.1%. In addition to the random responses, there were 157 volunteer responses, for a total response of 524. Survey results can be found at www.oshtemo.org, or at the Township customer service desk.
