Discussion on USDA Sewer Expansion

Public Works Anna Horner presented information for funding sewer capital projects. The focus of funding sewer capital projects is to keep the resident connection cost low. The Board needs to consider an internal transfer of \$1-1.5M, setting the residential connection fee at \$7,500 for USDA projects, and recognize that future bonding may be required. Board consensus was to consider an internal transfer from the General Fund since the Township will not have to pay interest.
