Oshtemo Township Trends and Analysis

August saw Calls for Service in Oshtemo Township reported at **1871**. The Adjusted Calls for Service number was **1514**. This number is achieved when the calls for service complaints are subtracted by the pro-active calls for service of Directed Patrols, Public Relations and Fire and Rescue calls during this time period.

Assaults were reported at **31** for August. There was **1** Robbery reported. There was **2** Child Abuse case reported. The number of Sex Offense cases reported was reported at **2**.

Retail Frauds were reported at **44** for the month of August. Larcenies were reported at **52**. Home Invasions were reported at **9**.

Non-Criminal Calls were reported at **682** for the month of August.

Miscellaneous Criminal Calls and Frauds were reported at **77** for the month of August.

Vehicle Crashes were reported at **103** for the month of August.

Traffic Summary: Total Traffic stops were **386** for the month of August.

Citations issued: Citations issued for the month of August was **240**.

Detective Bureau News

KCSO Detectives working in Oshtemo Township reported Daniel Richard Lee who has been a person of interest in the Chemical Bank Robbery that occurred on July 27, 2018 has been apprehended. KCSO detectives spend 125 hours working with local and federal agents to locate Lee. Lee admitted to detectives in Ohio that he had robbed numerous banks, including the Chemical Bank over the past few weeks. The FBI has taken over our case. Oshtemo Township deputies have taken several larceny from vehicles complaints in the month of August. Our Detective Bureau is working with deputies and has developed a person of interest who they believe to be responsible for most of the larcenies. He is currently in custody on other charges and the DB will continue to build their larceny cases.

Community Policing

Lieutenant Michelle Greenlee, Deputy Dave Rowe and many other officers from KCSO participated in National Night Out August 7th, 2018. Local Fire, EMS, community businesses and members joined in the celebration. National Night Out is an annual community-building event that promotes public service-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make our neighborhoods safer, more caring places to live.

Lieutenant Michelle Greenlee and Deputy Dave Rowe continue to teach classes on Active Assailant Awareness Training for citizens in Kalamazoo County and Oshtemo Township. Employees at Trader Joe's hosted a presentation on 08/28/2018. These classes focus personal awareness and how to respond in the event you encounter an active assailant. Dep. Benton participated in a back to school event hosted at Trader Joe's on 08/18/2018. Lt. Greenlee assisted Kalamazoo Christian Elementary and Middle school with a safety and security building check on 08/17/2018. Lt. Greenlee also welcomed Kalamazoo Christian Elementary students back to school on 08/21/2018. Lots of high five's and pencils were handed out.

CPO Dep. Dave Rowe also met with 30 various apartment and mobile home complexes within Oshtemo Township and discussed any crime concerns and crime reduction strategies within their complexes.

Sgt. JuVon Johnson and CPO Dep. Dave Rowe both responded to Copper Beech Apartment complex on August 24, 2018 for a baby not breathing. Sgt. Johnson and Dep. Rowe administered lifesaving efforts clearing the child's air way prior to rescue arriving on scene. The child survived the incident and was alert and crying prior to EMS transporting him to the hospital for examination.

 - c. Rape (All Criminal Sexual Conduct cases and Indecent Exposure cases)

 - f. All other violent crimes including Violation of Controlled Substance Act and Resisting and Obstructing an Officer.
- 2. Property Crimes**
 - a. Breaking & Entering (Non Dwelling)
 - b. Home Invasions (Residential Dwellings)
 - c. Retail Frauds
 - d. Larcenies (Includes Larceny from Vehicle)
 - e. Unlawful Driving Away of a Automobile

- d. All Other Property Crimes related including Malicious Destruction of Property calls

3. Non Criminal Complaints

- a. Alarms (Includes False Alarms and Fire Alarms)
- b. Noise Complaints
- c. Suspicious Occurrence
- d. All other crimes which don't fit into other categories

4. Miscellaneous Criminal Complaints

- a. Frauds, Embezzlement
- b. Other

- a. Fatal
- b. Personal Injury Crashes














