Oshtemo Township Trends and Analysis

September saw Calls for Service in Oshtemo Township reported at **1663**. The Adjusted Calls for Service number was **1269**. This number is achieved when the calls for service complaints are subtracted by the pro-active calls for service of Directed Patrols, Public Relations and Fire and Rescue calls during this time period.

Assaults were reported at **25** for September. No Robberies reported. There was **3** Child Abuse case reported. The number of Sex Offense cases reported was reported at **1**.

Retail Frauds were reported at **47** for the month of September. Larcenies were reported at **42**. Home Invasions were reported at **12**.

Non-Criminal Calls were reported at **628** for the month of September.

Miscellaneous Criminal Calls and Frauds were reported at **63** for the month of September.

Vehicle Crashes were reported at **90** for the month of September.

Traffic Summary: Total Traffic stops were **315** for the month of September.

Citations issued: Citations issued for the month of September was **189**.

Detective Bureau News

KCSO Detectives working in Oshtemo Township reported on September 14th an armed home invasion at the 1300 block of Concord Apartments at 01:38am. The female victim reported she was woken up by three unknown male suspects who had forced entry into her apartment. The victim reported being held at gunpoint while her apartment was ransacked. Suspects in this case have not been identified.

On September 17th, 2018 at approximately 07:09am KCSO detectives reported a Burglary with Forced Entry at the Westport Village Condominiums. It is believed the suspect set fire to the condominium prior to leaving the residence. No residents were home at the time of the incident. KCSO detectives are still following leads in this investigation.

On September 30, 2018 at approximately 04:30am in the 1300 block of Concord Apartments a Calvin Carter stabbed a Charles Hough. Responding Deputies located Hough outside the area of 1319 Concord. Hough was transported to Bronson hospital where he succumb to his injuries. The suspect in this investigation was located inside an apartment, arrested and charged with murder.

 - c. Rape (All Criminal Sexual Conduct cases and Indecent Exposure cases)

 - f. All other violent crimes including Violation of Controlled Substance Act and Resisting and Obstructing an Officer.
- 2. Property Crimes**
 - a. Breaking & Entering (Non Dwelling)
 - b. Home Invasions (Residential Dwellings)
 - c. Retail Frauds
 - d. Larcenies (Includes Larceny from Vehicle)
 - e. Unlawful Driving Away of a Automobile

- d. All Other Property Crimes related including Malicious Destruction of Property calls

3. Non Criminal Complaints

- a. Alarms (Includes False Alarms and Fire Alarms)
- b. Noise Complaints
- c. Suspicious Occurrence
- d. All other crimes which don't fit into other categories

4. Miscellaneous Criminal Complaints

- a. Frauds, Embezzlement
- b. Other

5. Vehicle Crashes

- a. Fatal
- b. Personal Injury Crashes
- c. Property Damage Crashes
- d. Hit and Run Crashes
- e. Private Property Crashes
















