Oshtemo Township Trends and Analysis

October saw Calls for Service in Oshtemo Township reported at **1,639**. The Adjusted Calls for Service number was **1,266**. This number is achieved when the calls for service complaints are subtracted by the pro-active calls for service of Directed Patrols, Public Relations and Fire and Rescue calls during this time period.

Assaults were reported at **16** for October. **Robberies** reported at **1**. No Child Abuse cases reported. The number of Sex Offense cases reported was reported at **3**.

Retail Frauds were reported at **64** for the month of October. Larcenies were reported at **41** and Home Invasions were reported at **5**.

Non-Criminal Calls were reported at **584** for the month of October.

Miscellaneous Criminal Calls and Non-Retail Frauds were reported at **61** for the month of October.

Vehicle Crashes were reported at **99** for the month of October.

Traffic Summary: Total Traffic stops were **339** for the month of October.

Citations issued: Citations issued for the month of October was **186**.

Detective Bureau News

Over the last few months Oshtemo Township along with jurisdictions all over Kalamazoo County have been experiencing mail thefts and frauds related to mail thefts. In collaborating with authorities from jurisdictions throughout the county three main suspects have been identified. It is believed these suspects have been prolific in stealing mail and specifically checks sent in the mail. It is believed they have been washing the checks and cashing them at various businesses throughout Kalamazoo County and in Oshtemo Township.

In October the Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Office along with, Detectives from the Kalamazoo Department of Public Safety and Portage Police Department presented several larceny from mail and fraud charges to the US Postal Inspector and the Federal Prosecutors Office. Indictments have been issued on three suspects for Conspiracy to Commit Bank Fraud, Possession of Stolen Mail, Possession of Unauthorized Transaction Devices, and Aggravated Identity Theft.

This is currently a sealed indictment however once they are captured and arrested the indictment may be unsealed for public record. Jurisdictions throughout the county are working together to capture and secure these individuals.

Community Policing

Community Policing Officer Dep. Dave Rowe gave 5 Active Assailant Awareness Presentations in October. Four were held at the Fountains and one was held at Odyssey Games in Oshtemo. October 16-19th Dep. Rowe attended the Crime Prevention Association of Michigan Conference in Traverse City. On October 23, Dep. Rowe conducted a Neighborhood Watch Presentation for the Coddington Neighborhood and met with members of the Buckham Highlands HOA about crime and traffic questions. Lieutenant Michelle Greenlee met with the West Port Village Safety and Security Committee on October 18th reference access to the gated community and security questions.

Deputy Dave Rowe continues to teach classes on Active Assailant Awareness Training for citizens in Kalamazoo County and Oshtemo Township. These classes focus personal awareness and how to respond in the event you encounter an active assailant.  - f. All other violent crimes including Violation of Controlled Substance Act and Resisting and Obstructing an Officer.
- 2. Property Crimes**
 - a. Breaking & Entering (Non Dwelling)
 - b. Home Invasions (Residential Dwellings)
 - c. Retail Frauds
 - d. Larcenies (Includes Larceny from Vehicle)
 - e. Unlawful Driving Away of a Automobile

- d. All Other Property Crimes related including Malicious Destruction of Property calls

3. Non Criminal Complaints

- a. Alarms (Includes False Alarms and Fire Alarms)
- b. Noise Complaints
- c. Suspicious Occurrence
- d. All other crimes which don't fit into other categories

4. Miscellaneous Criminal Complaints

- a. Frauds, Embezzlement
- b. Other

- a. Fatal
- b. Personal Injury Crashes
- c. Property Damage Crashes
















