**REVISED – BOIL WATER ADVISORY
Water Infrastructure Repair
South 6th Street, Oshtemo Township**

September 10, 2019, Kalamazoo MI – The City of Kalamazoo is in the process of repairing a water leak on South 6th Street. The work resulted in a temporary loss of pressure and consequently, a precautionary boil water advisory is being issued in cooperation with the Kalamazoo County Health and Community Services Department for all water intended for drinking or ingestion or any consumptive uses within the affected area, including:

South 6th Street – West ML Avenue (northern boundary) to Stadium Drive (southern boundary), both sides of the street. Includes only the City of Kalamazoo Water customers.

This advisory is precautionary only; there have not been any confirmed tests showing bacteria present in the water main at the location of the infrastructure repair. Initial sampling results will be available within 24 hours of its collection and the final set within 48 hours. It is expected that the advisory will be lifted within 72 hours (September 13).

Municipal water customers in the affected area may use bottled water for consumptive purposes or boil their tap water for 2 minutes prior to use for drinking or other ingestion. No special precautionary measures are necessary for water used for personal hygiene.
